At the end of the ceremony, Medcom invited Unimal to tour the facilities including the broadcast room, production room, control room, and others. This milestone hopefully can elevate the spirit of inclusiveness and pro-change for Unimal that was proclaimed from the beginning of Herman Fithra's leadership, and become something great in the near future.
